 Thank you for the world and our friends and family


Sorry for everything that everyone has done that's bad

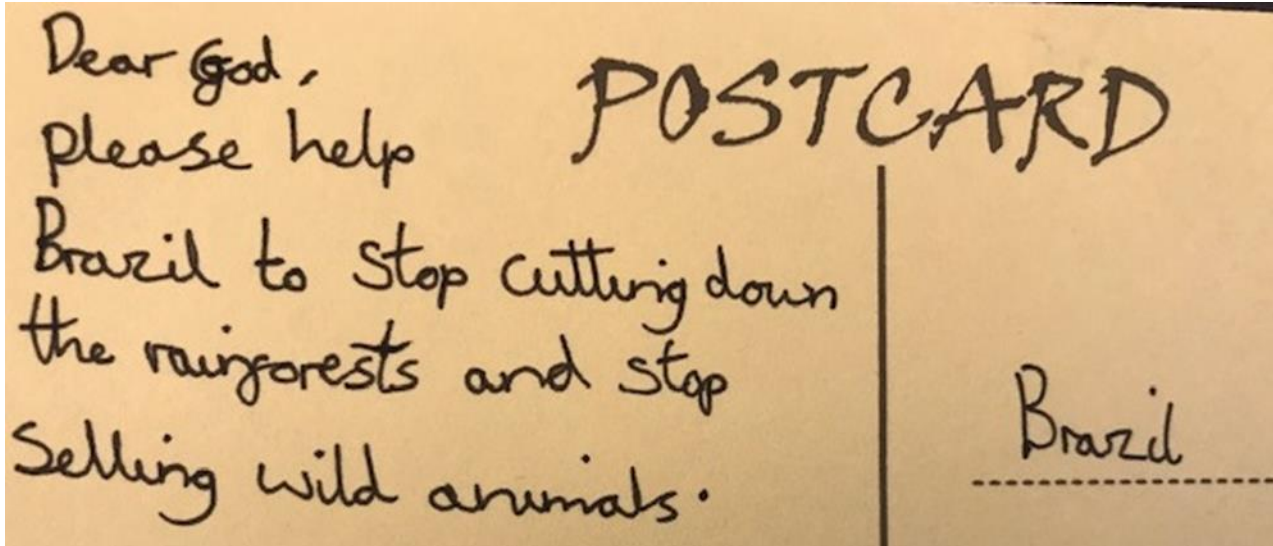

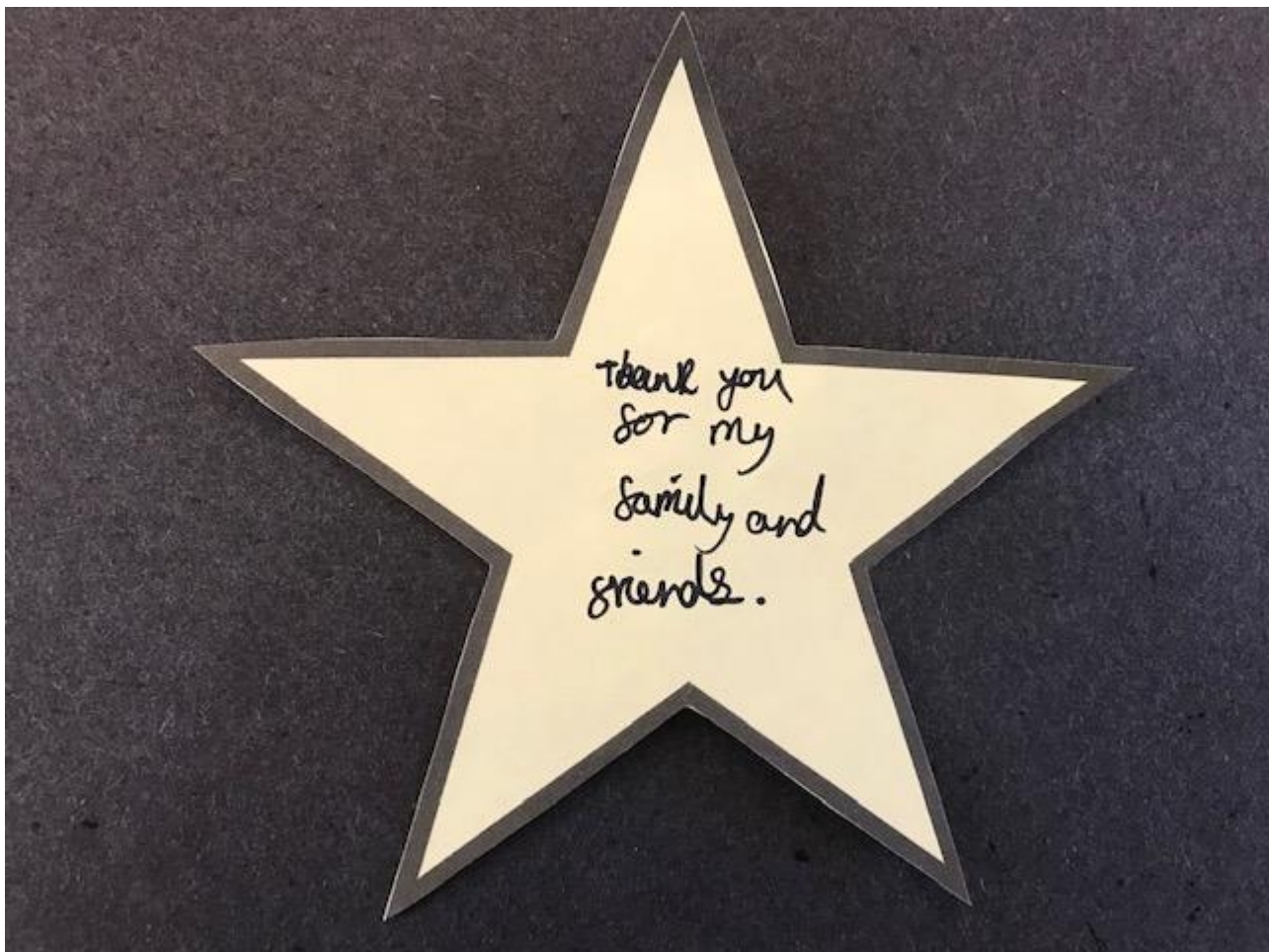

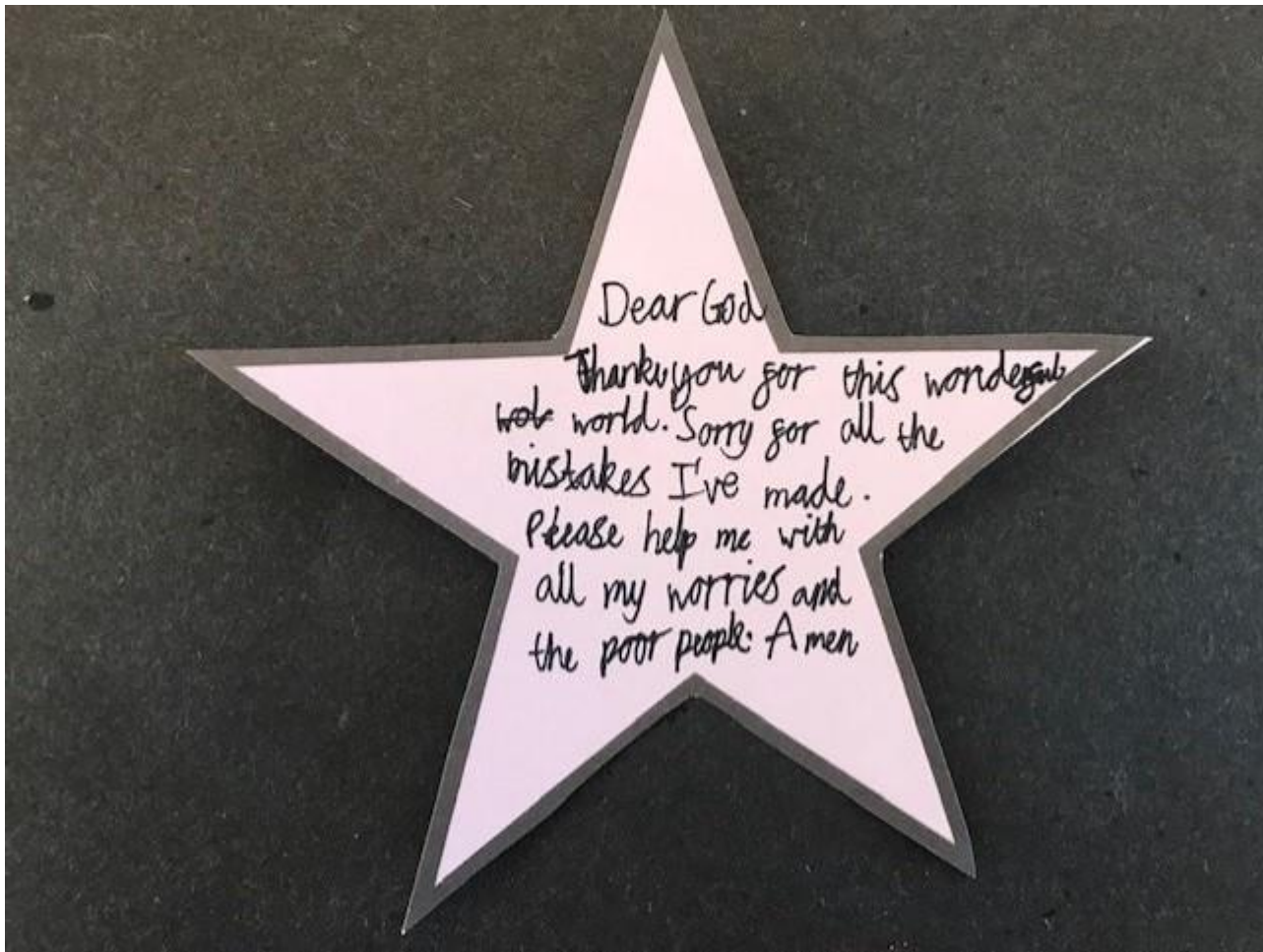

From a Governor I was delighted to be involved in the Prayer Space; it was so well organised and children from all age groups were fully engaged in the activities.

One activity that I was attached to was the 'Sorry Shredder' - after the children had written their prayers, they were shredded, so no evidence remains!

Some children shared what they were sorry about: causing an upset at home with family or squabbling with siblings, or breaking friendships at school - a common theme.

Afterwards, when they had used the shredder, asked how they felt, they all replied, 'a sense of relief, a huge worry had been lifted off my shoulders, I felt happy, I felt at peace with myself.' Something we can all identify with - a real blessing.
