## What can you do to support your child

## Reading

- Please read with your child regularly
- Check your child is reading a book in their ZPD (www.arbookfind.co.uk)- Go through AR on Broadwater website.
- Encourage your child to quiz as soon as they finish a book. You can still quiz at home.
- Read to your child as well as with them


## Homework

- Set on Wednesday and due in on the following Wednesday each week via Google Classroom.
- It is preferred that homework is completed online, but homework books can be provided if requested.
- Usually a Maths and English task set each week that reflects what is taught at school and some spellings to learn.
