They would need to bring the costume with them and get changed when they arrive at school. These outfits do not require you to purchase any extra items you do not already have at home. The children's normal school uniform such as a white shirt and trousers/skirt would be sufficient.

You may want to make a gas mask box at home out of a cardboard box and string and bring a teddy or small brown suitcase to hold. I have put some ideas at the bottom of this letter. Please do not feel any pressure to organise an elaborate costume as it will only be used for the assembly itself.
