## Y6 Trip to Shoreham – Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> October 2023 and

Visit from Novium Museum with workshop – Tues 31<sup>st</sup> October

As part of our topic 'From Coast to Coast', we are planning a visit to Shoreham-by-sea on **Tuesday 3**<sup>rd</sup> **October**. We will be visiting two locations during the day:

**Shoreham Port**, to find out about the imports and exports, local land use, influence of the port on the development of the town; and the



RNLI Life Boat station, to learn about their role in keeping safe in the harbour.

We are planning to travel to and from Southwick station by train. Please could you arrange for your child to meet us outside the front of **Worthing Central Station** (near the booking hall) <u>promptly between 8.45 and 9.00am</u>. After our visit we will return by train and then walk back to school within the normal school day – children will be collected from school as usual.

## In addition to our visit to Shoreham, we have also booked a visiting workshop about smuggling, run by the Novium Museum in Chichester. They will be visiting our school on Tuesday 31<sup>st</sup> October.

We are asking for a voluntary contribution of **£7.75** per child to cover the cost of the trip and the workshop together. If you are already signed up with **PARENTPAY** you can pay this online by debit or credit card, by paying this way you automatically give consent for this trip. In the event that we do not have sufficient contributions to fund this trip, it may be need to be cancelled. We will, of course, always be ready to help in cases of genuine financial difficulty – <u>please do speak in confidence</u> to the School Finance Assistant.

Your child will need to wear suitable clothing for being outside - whatever the weather. Children will need to have a **waterproof coat** and shoes that are suitable for walking, they should wear the **school uniform top** and their own **comfortable trousers**. Please provide a packed lunch and a drink, but no items containing nuts of any kind, fizzy drinks or glass bottles please.

It would be impossible to run our trips without your help, and we would be very grateful of any extra adult help (Broadwater DBS required). If you are able to help on this day, please contact the school office.

Inhalers and auto injectors that are normally kept in the classroom and in the medical room will be taken out on the trip, on the day. If children require prescribed medicines, they must be in their original packaging, which must include the label with the prescribed dose and the patient information leaflet. Non-prescribed medication (e.g for travel-sickness) must also be in its original packaging, and include dosage details.

As a reminder if you have already booked and paid for school hot lunches for this date please make sure you cancel this before Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> September, also if you are entitled to a free school lunch it is possible to book a Chartwells trip packed lunch but this needs to be done via ParentPay by the stated date.
